All children need to have the new white polo shirt for PE from September.

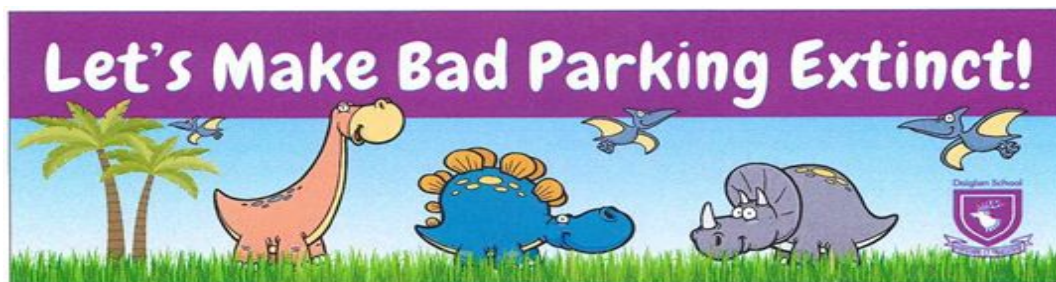
Upon return after the half term break in November full winter uniform should be worn. Please ensure that you have purchased all items required in advance of the change whilst stocks are high.
